

# Fall 2024 Payment Plan Options

Northwest Louisiana Technical Community College has partnered with Higher One CashNet to provide easy and convenient methods to pay your entire semester bill or through installments.

### Fall 2024 Payment Plan 1

(4 payment option open until 08/25/2024)
1st payment due at Registration
2nd payment on 09/29/2024
3rd payment on 10/27/2024
4th payment on 11/24/2024

\*\*\*\*\*\*Enrolled students must have started a payment plan, received a scholarship, been awarded FAFSA financial aid or paid the balance in full by 08/15/2024 to avoid being dropped from classes.

Students enrolling in the 2nd 8 week term, may enroll in Payment Plan 2, shown below.

1st 8 week/16 week term classes begin 08/12/2024 2nd 8 week term classes begin 10/14/2024

\*Note: Students who drop classes within the first 5 days of the 1st class will receive 100% refund.

- 6. Last, click on PAYMENT OPTIONS link at the bottom of the screen.
- 7. Once directed to the new page, you may make a full payment or enroll in the current semester payment plan.
