




Northwest Louisiana Technical Community College- Chancellor's Data Report Narrative (10/2022)

The October 2022 Chancellor's Data Report reflects the number of Responsible Employees at Northwest Louisiana Technical Community College (NLTCC) and the number of Responsible Employees who completed the Board of Regents' Power Based Violence training.

Power-Based Violence training with a due date of August 31, 2022, was provided to all Responsible Employees at NLTCC. A total of 133 Responsible Employees completed the training for a 100% completion rate. NLTCC currently has 3 Confidential Advisors for the college. The Confidential Advisor training was also completed at a rate of 100%.

In addition to the Power Based Violence training, NLTCC has taken steps to assure all students and employees are aware of and trained on Title IX are as follows: Title IX training is provided to all students through freshman orientation, Title IX is reviewed annually with all employees at professional development events, and the LCTCS Title IX Responsible Employee flyer along with an internal Title IX training is distributed to all new hires. NLTCC has recently contracted with Get Inclusive to deliver Title IX training to both employees and students throughout the academic year on a regular basis. In addition to Title IX training, all employees are responsible for completing the Preventing Sexual Harassment training annually. Employees who are supervisors complete both the Preventing Sexual Harassment training and the Preventing Sexual Harassment for Supervisors training.
